### MALVAR



**Origin:** This variety originates from Spain and more particularly from the Madrid area. It is also found in La Mancha under the names Mondéjar, Ribera del Guadiana and last but not least, Vinos de Madrid. It is here that it is found as the main grape variety. It is also known in the regions of Cuenca and Cáceres.

- **Colour:** White Grape
- **Date of first crop:** First introduced in Abela in 1885
- **Area:** 215ha in 2009, but it has almost disappeared
- **Maturity:** Early ripening
- **Yields:** low yields
- **Vulnerabilities:** Hardy varietal. Moderate susceptibility to powdery mildew and also favoured by birds.
- **General characteristics:** Bunches are generally large with yellow-green fruit. It produces light, fresh wines with pleasant acidity and some aniseed notes. The nose is filled with marked aromatic depth, with hints of bitter almonds. Ages well in barrels.
- **Synonyms:** No known synonyms but there is a variety called Marfal in Cáceres

### Raices Malvar 2018

D.O. Vinos de Madrid • 12,5% Vol.

Clear and brilliant colour, a beautiful pale yellow with emerald highlights. Fruity, mineral nose with hints of white fruit and white flowers. Fresh and generous on the palate with spicy and musky notes, combined with a dash of alcohol and cut grass. Excellent lengthy finish.

**Pairings:** Pasta, rice, fish, either fried or in a creamy sauce, seafood platter, risotto with truffle and scallops or Valençay, Crottin de Chavignol or young Comté cheeses.
